The RCCF Richard S. Earnest Diabetes Scholarship

Applicants for this scholarship must:

- The student must be a graduating senior of RCHS and also a permanent resident of Rush County.
- The student must have Type I insulin dependent diabetes and provide a signed statement from their physician.
- The student must show proof of acceptance at an accredited two or four year institution.
- In the event a student with Type I insulin dependent diabetes does not apply, consideration will be given to an RCHS senior entering an Indiana college or university with preference given to a student planning to become a medical doctor and enrolled in pre-med classes.

In order to be considered for this scholarship, a completed application package must be submitted to the Rush County Community Foundation office by the application deadline as stated on the scholarship application.

PLEASE NOTE – APPLICATION PACKAGE

For your application to be considered this cover page and the following information is to be attached together at the time of submission to constitute a complete application package. If not, your application will be discarded and not considered:

1. A completed Rush County Community Foundation Scholarship Program application with Pages 4 and 5 signed by the student applicant, spouse if applicable and parents if applicable with Page 5 witnessed by a non family member
2. A current official transcript or a copy of a current official transcript showing credits attempted, credits earned and grades
3. Signed statement from physician if Type 1 diabetic, if applicable
4. Proof of acceptance at an accredited 2 or 4 year institution
5. Current FAFSA Form
