The RCCF Thomas F. Marshall Scholarship

Revised July 2010

Applicants for this scholarship must:

- be a Rush County, Indiana resident or a direct descendent of a Rush County resident. Descendents must provide name of their direct descendant from Rush County.
- be a full time college student in their third year or above in good standing. Preference will be given to students studying in the fields of mental health, social work, health care, or law. If there are no applicants in those particular fields, then this scholarship may be awarded to any college student in their third year or above.
- provide a signed letter of explanation regarding what and why the applicant chose their field of study and what the intended use of their degree is in the future.

The recipient may apply and receive this scholarship more than one year. No relative or direct descendent of any Founding Contributor or Thomas F. Marshall is eligible for this scholarship.

In order to be considered for this scholarship, a completed application package must be submitted to the Rush County Community Foundation office by the application deadline as stated on the scholarship application.

For your application to be considered this cover page and the following information is to be attached together at the time of submission to constitute a complete application package. **If not, your application will be discarded and not considered:**

1. A completed current year Rush County Community Foundation Scholarship Program application with Pages 4 and 5 signed by the student applicant, spouse if applicable and parents if applicable with Page 5 witnessed by a non family member
2. A current official transcript or a copy of a current official transcript showing credits attempted, credits earned and grades.
3. Letter of explanation regarding what and why the applicant chose their field of study and what the intended use of their degree is in the future.
